



Information Pursuant to Art. 13 and Art. 21 Basic Data Protection Ordinance (DSGVO) on Events

The following paragraphs inform you, as a participant in the event, about our processing of your data and your rights under data protection law in accordance with Art. 13 DSGVO.

For what purposes and on what legal basis do we process your data?

The processing of photos and/or video recordings (collection, storage and forwarding to third parties) and the publication of selected image files in (printed) publications of the organizer and/or cooperating partners and on the Internet serve the purposes of public relations and reportage on the respective event and are carried out on the basis of Art. 6, paragraph 1, sentence 1, lit. f DSGVO.

You will be notified of the processing and publication of your data via appropriate information in connection with the respective event.

What types of data do we process?

We process only photos and/or video clips that we take. It cannot be ruled out that sound recordings may also be included in the video recordings.

To whom do we transmit your data?

The photos and/or video recordings are published on the Internet (e.g. www.dog.org) and in social media (e.g. Facebook, Twitter) for public relations and reporting purposes. For the printing of publications, the data will be transmitted to suitable service providers. If necessary, contracts for order processing will be concluded.

Are data transferred to a third country or to an international organization?

As a general rule, your photos and/or video recordings will not be transferred to a country outside the EU. If photos and/or video recordings are published on Facebook, they will also be transmitted to the USA.

How long do we store your data?

After revocation, we will delete photos and/or video recordings that we have made. Please note that publication on the Internet

or on Facebook does not always guarantee comprehensive deletion.

What data protection rights do you have?

If the legal requirements are met, you are particularly entitled to the following rights according to Art. 15 to Art. 22 DSGVO:

The right to information, correction, deletion, restriction of processing and data transferability. In addition, Art. 13, paragraph 2 b) in conjunction with Art. 21 DSGVO gives you the right to object to the processing based on Art. 6, paragraph 1 f) DSGVO.

Pursuant to Art. 77 DSGVO, you have the right to complain to the supervisory authority if you are of the opinion that the processing of your personal data has not been carried out lawfully.

Information on your right of objection pursuant to Art. 21 DSGVO:

You have the right, for reasons arising from your particular situation, to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning you which is carried out on the basis of Art. 6, paragraph 1 f) DSGVO (data processing on the basis of a weighing of interests). If you file an objection, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can prove compelling reasons for processing worthy of protection which outweigh your interests or the processing serves to assert legal claims or defend against them.

You have the right to object at any time to the processing of personal data for advertising purposes. If you object to the processing for advertising purposes, we will no longer process your personal data for these purposes.
